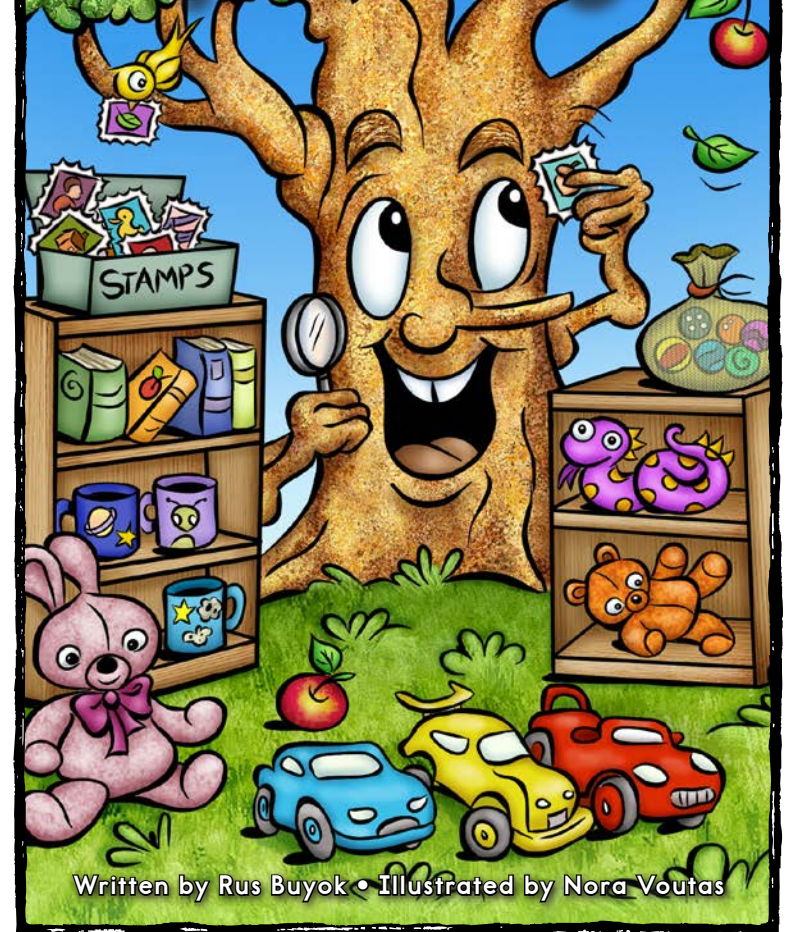

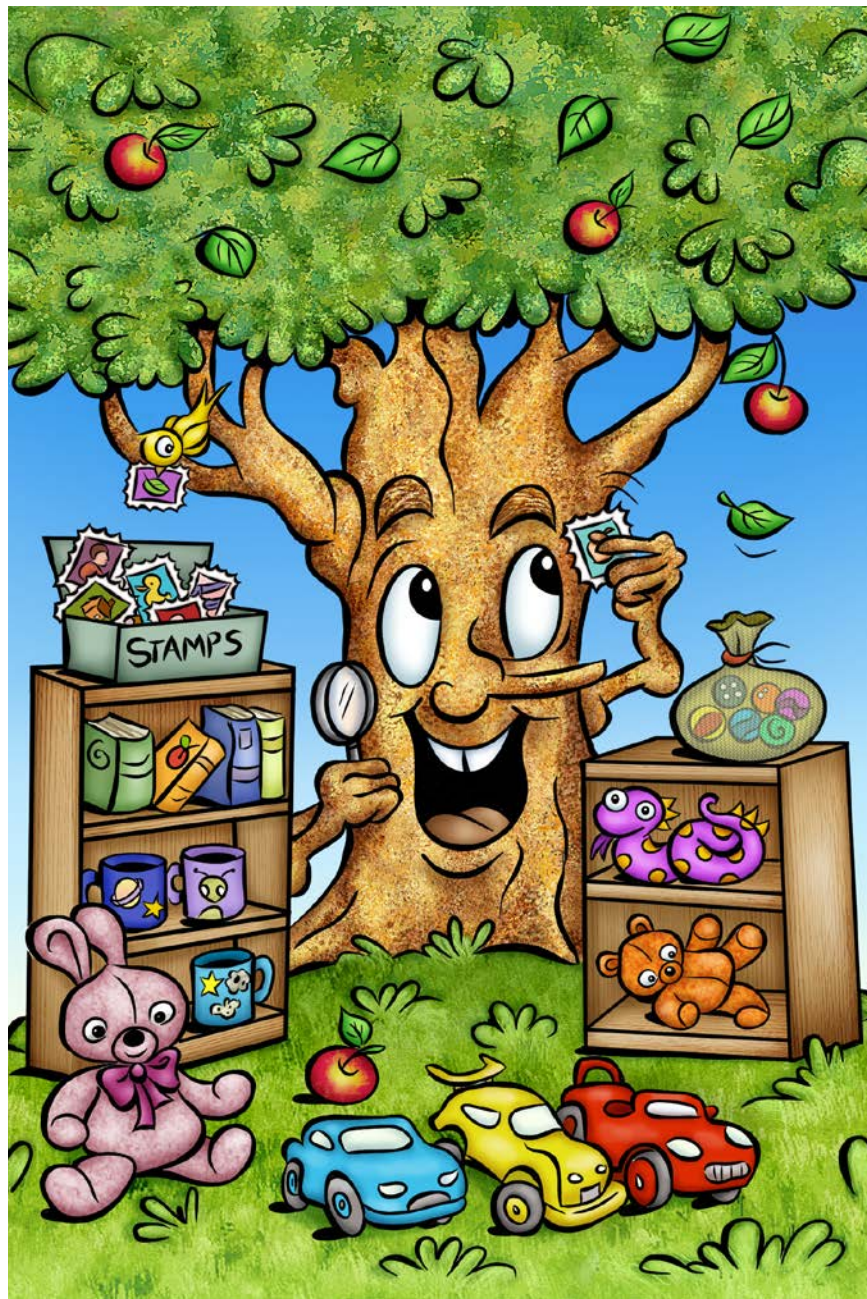

Tosh liked collecting things.



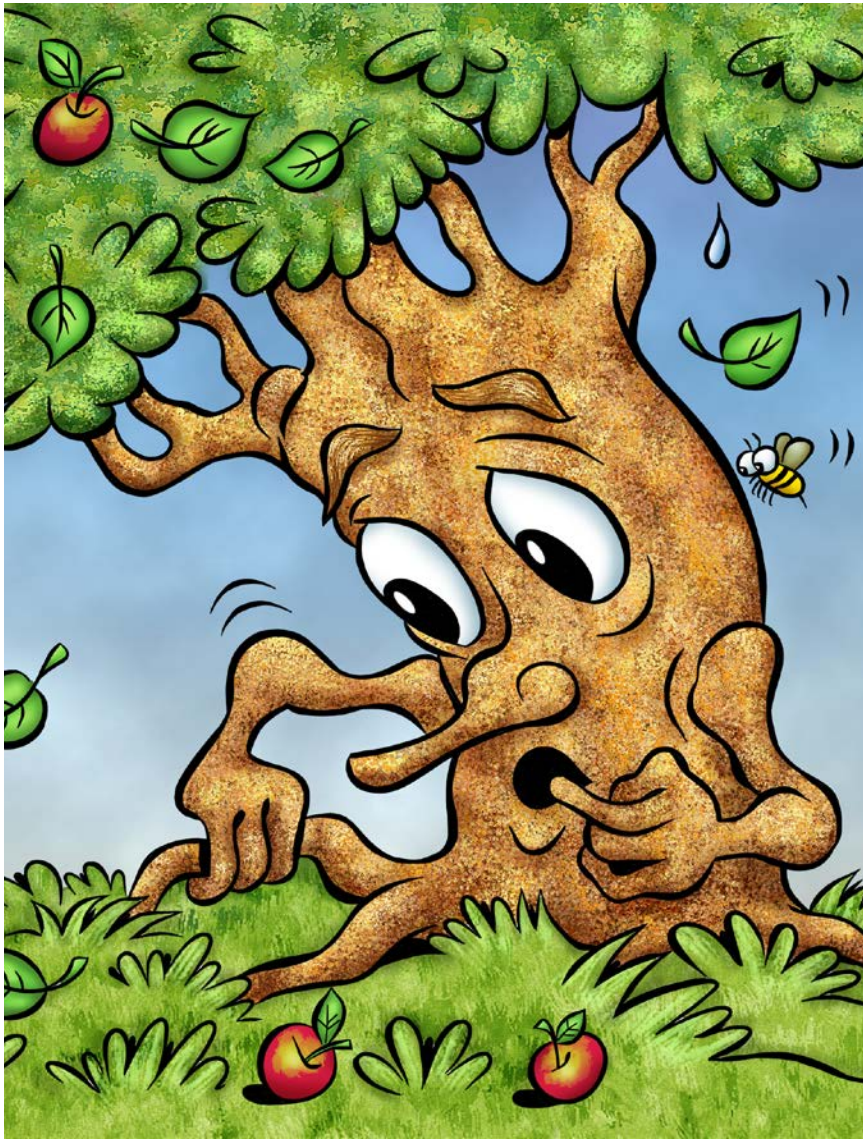
One day a big storm came.

He looked on the ground.



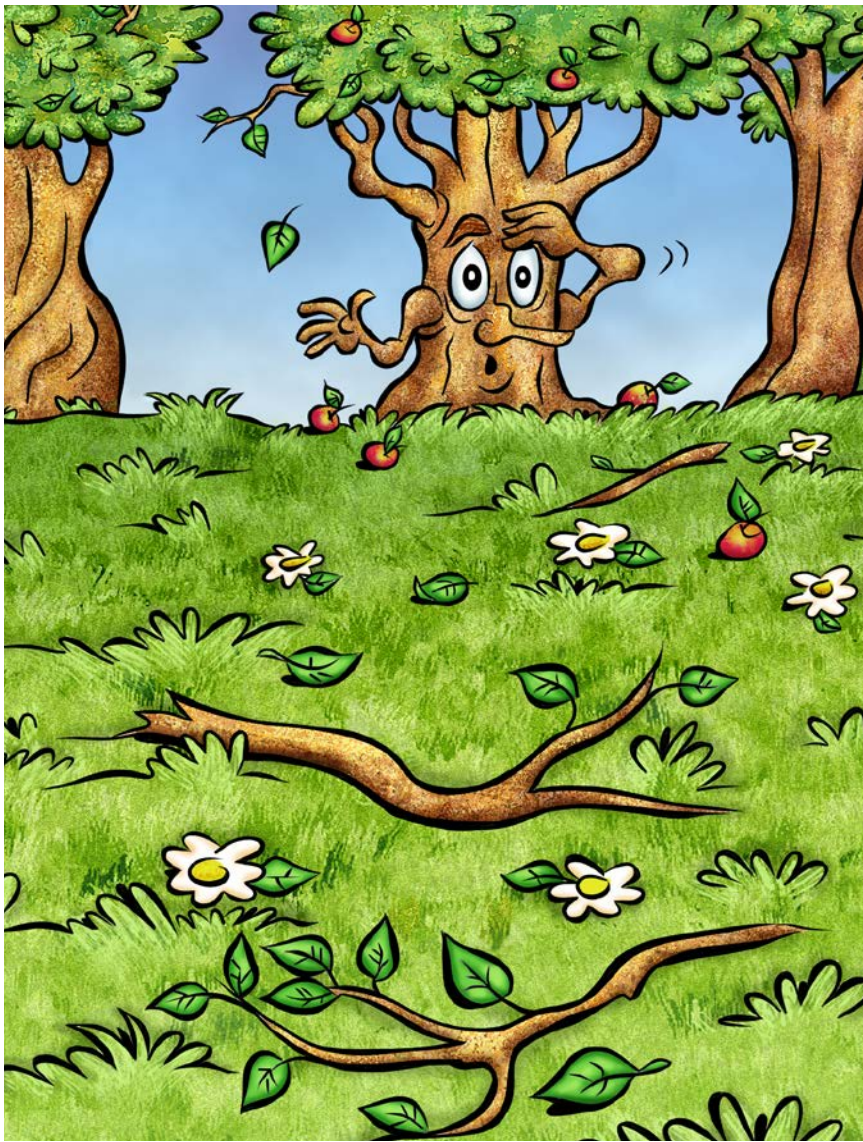
“Where are my books?”

He looked around his roots.



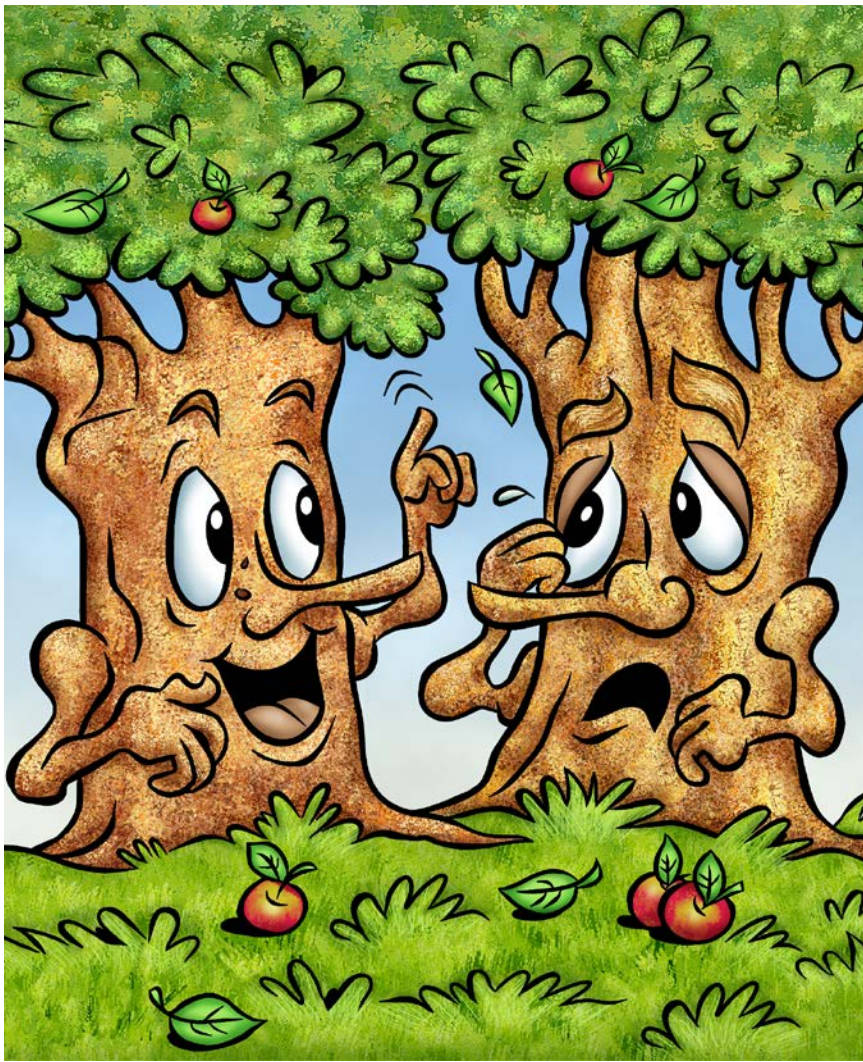
“Where are my animals?”
