We like to find new places to picnic.




I walk down a trail after lunch.

I see a big blue butterfly.


"Look!" I call out.

Oops! I tripped!




The sky looks dark.

"We'll ride to the hospital," he says.




The doctor meets us at the hospital.


Mom and dad look at my ankle.
