
It is a stormy day and the monsters are playing inside. First, Bonk, Lurk and Uzzle pretend they are cowboys.



Next, they pretend to work in a circus.




Then, they pretend to race cars around an oval track.



"My room is a mess," says Bonk.


"Let's play quietly for a while."

"Watching the rain is quiet," says Uzzle.


The monsters watch the storm out the window.






Then, Bonk has an idea. "I know what we can do!" says Bonk.

outside.





Thunder rattles the house.
