







"I'm so glad they let us feed the animals," says Uzzle.


"I'll get carrots for the donkey," says Lurk.









"I'll get corn for the goats," says Bonk.





His pocket has a small hole.




The monsters play with the animals.

They feed them, too.


Bonk forgets about the corn.




On the way home, the corn drops out on the trail.



One of the goats at the zoo escapes. He follows Bonk's trail of corn. The monsters do not notice.







At home, they notice.


"Bah!" says the goat.

"How do we get him back to the zoo?" says Bonk.


Bonk and the monsters gently push the goat.
